History	<p>1873: Opening of the „Hotel Krafft“ by Ernst Krafft. The hotel is located on the bank of the Rhine in Kleinbasel.</p> <p>Beginning of the 20th century: Not only hotel guests stay at the Krafft but also pensioners. Among them the famous author Hermann Hesse, who writes his novel „Der Steppenwolf“ in room 49 (today room 401).</p> <p>1946: Family Waldmeier takes over the hotel. It becomes one of the most prestigious hotels in Basel.</p> <p>1958: Renovation and extension of the hotel.</p>	
Today	Since 2003 the foundation Edith Maryon has been the owner of the hotel. The management company Krafft Gruppe from Basel has a longstanding rental agreement.
